#### Update on the Follow-up Trips to Germany

More than 50 saints participated in the first Follow-up Gospel Trip in Germany. This trip was a follow-up and further labor to the FTTA Gospel Trip in January to continue to shepherd the contacts that were made from that trip. The following are some small reports from this trip:

One of the translators said that "I am not working for you, but I am one with you." One of the saints on the trip felt that every word that is spoken to the refugees is significant because they are open. Another saint testified that the Lord supplied him more than He has ever done in his entire Christian life. He felt unqualified, but the words just came when he needed them. The hardest thing for the saints related to the trip was to leave these ones because they were on their heart. At one of the camps there was an outstanding response: a crowd of close to 50 all at once wanted further contact, and the people were giving contact information to the saints. The saints sensed that they knew how the Lord felt when he needed to step into the boat because of the large crowd. Several saints testified that the prayer, the enjoyment in the word, and the blending with the saints were the vital components for the entire gospel trip. This is what it means to be a real priest. It is not an outward work but an inward flow of life.

Please pray for the raising up and perfecting of the translators. Pray as well for those who are capable in the language among us to perfect these ones. Pray also for the Lord to gain this harvest for Himself, and pray for the saints who live in Germany to know the bountiful supply of the Spirit to meet every need.
