Please pray that the Lord's up-to-date speaking will operate in all the brothers for the development of the kingdom of God in all the churches in Europe.

Dear Saints,

Gdansk is the main and leading city in northern Poland with almost 500,000 inhabitants. With two neighboring cities, Sopot and Gdynia, it forms an urban area of 1.1 million people. There are many universities in these three cities with a collective population of approximately 100,000 students. Most of them come from nearby localities, and some come also from abroad. There are three churches in the vicinity of Gdansk, the closest being about 45 minutes away by car.

During the preparations for the FTTA gospel trip in January 2019, a thought emerged among the serving ones in Poland that, while visiting churches in the north of Poland, the trainees, along with serving ones from Warsaw and local saints, could also conduct a two-day distribution of the Polish New Testament Recovery Version in Gdansk near the University of Gdansk, which is the largest university in that area.

During the distributions the saints encountered a very good atmosphere and openness among the students whom they contacted. This encouraged the serving ones and the saints in Poland to continue to visit this city after the FTTA gospel trip. Four distributions were conducted from February until today, in which a total of over 700 New Testaments were given away. Dozens of good conversations were held, and while the Lord had a way to sow His Word, eight students received the Lord. We are still in contact with some of them, and new contacts continue to appear. In the Gdansk urban area three young saints from the church life are currently studying. We are in contact with these students, and they join the Bibles for Europe distributions as much as possible.

Prayer burdens:

1. That the Lord will burden at least two families and two single saints to migrate and live near the University of Gdansk, so that we can take care of the students who are open to meet with us and the students from the church life who currently study there or intend to study there.
2. That the Lord will open the way for us to visit Gdansk regularly and burden the three nearby churches to join and participate in sowing and shepherding the students who are open for further contact.
3. That more students will be open to give us their contact information.
