Report from the Winter Youth Olympic Games in Switzerland (11-12 January)

On Saturday, 11 January 2020, about 40 saints from different countries in Europe and the US joined the local saints (about 40) for a Bible distribution in Lausanne during the Winter Olympic Games. After a good time of prayer and coordination they split up and went to four different cities (Lausanne, Morges, Vevey, Montreux). In some of those cities it was the very first time the saints had ever had a Bible distribution. In the afternoon the city center of Lausanne was filled with thousands of people attending the Olympic game events and the activities set up for the occasion. At that time all the saints gathered on site and went out in small groups to distribute gospel tracts and Bibles.

On the Lord's Day, 12 January, over a hundred saints were gathered together at the Lord's table. After a love feast the saints went out again to downtown Lausanne for another time of sowing. In total over 120 Bibles were distributed over the weekend and about two thousand gospel tracts in French and in English. Of all the recipients, four requested further contact with the saints, and two got saved and called on the name of the Lord.

We thank the Lord for such a sweet time of coordination and blending with all the members of the Body of Christ during those two days. We believe this was a real time of sowing. The local saints were encouraged to see the openness and the seeking of all the people, both Christians and unbelievers.

After the weekend, 12 FTTA trainees and local saints continued to go out to Lausanne and to the campus to contact more young people and follow up with those whom they met on the previous days.

May the Lord cause the seeds to grow!
