

Burdens related to Europe (week of 23 February 2020)

1) Meeting hall in Stuttgart — recent developments

The owner decided to lease the property to another tenant. Please continue to pray for an adequate meeting hall for the church in Stuttgart in the best location, at an affordable price, and readily accessible to public transportation.

2) Beginning of the spring semester of the FTTL, and the work on the university campuses in London

3) First Lord's table meeting in Zagreb, Croatia (1 March)

The Lord's move in Zagreb, the capital city of Croatia, began in 2012 with a brother who was reading books by Watchman Nee. Through a Croatian couple in the church life in Berlin, he was introduced to Witness Lee's writings. The two Croatian brothers maintained regular contact for the next four years, during which time the brother in Zagreb attended conferences in Europe and participated in one-week trainings in London. In 2016 the Croatian couple who had lived in Berlin moved to Zagreb. In the next three years the Lord added to them, and the number of saints in Zagreb is now 19. Please pray for a strong beginning of the church life in Zagreb.

Please pray that in a timely way the Lord will open the way for the needed renovations to be made.

5) Continuing prayer for the Lord's move in Germany and other German-speaking countries
