

Announcement Concerning the First Lord's Table in Lille, France

24–25 January 2026

To all the churches and to all the saints in the Lord's recovery:

"Peace to the brothers and love with faith from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ in incorruptibility." (Eph. 6:23–24)

With much thanksgiving to the Lord, we joyfully announce that, in His sovereignty and in the advancement of His move in Europe, **the first Lord's Table in the city of Lille, France, is scheduled for Lord's Day, 25 January 2026.**

Since 2021, the prayers for France have intensified, becoming a prevailing cry in one accord to the Lord for more golden lampstands in this country. Borne by these prayers, the gospel Bible distributions before and during the Olympics in 2024 brought saints from all over the earth to cooperate with the Lord in contacting many seekers He had prepared for Himself in France. Although the saints in Lille were few, many of these contacts were brought into ongoing shepherding in home meetings and small group meetings, with the help of visiting short-term shepherds from many parts of the earth. This has been nothing less than a genuine move in His Body. Through fervent prayer, labor in one accord, and the practical building in life and truth with the ministry of the age, the Lord has been pleased to raise up two new lampstands in France—Nanterre and Toulouse—and is **now bringing forth a shining golden lampstand in Lille**. How we praise and worship the Lord for His doing: "Unless Jehovah builds the house, / Those who build it labor in vain" (Psa. 127:1a).

We sense that this step is not merely local but is **for the Lord's testimony in Europe and for His recovery on the earth.**

"And they continued steadfastly in the teaching and the fellowship of the apostles, in the breaking of bread and the prayers... And day by day, continuing steadfastly with one accord in the temple and breaking bread from house to house, they partook of their food with exultation and simplicity of heart." (Acts 2:42, 46)

1. First Lord's Table in Lille

- **Date:** Lord's Day, 25 January 2026
- **Venue:** The meetings will be held at **Les espaces Canopy** in **Vieux-Lille**, at 46 rue Négrier, Lille 59800, France
- **Purpose:** To partake of the Lord's Table and to **begin the church life in Lille, France**, in a definite and practical way, as the local expression of the one Body of Christ.
- **Burden:** That the Lord may gain in Lille a shining lampstand, a testimony of Jesus, for the building up of His Body and the preparation of His Bride for His soon return.

- **Pray much** for these days in Lille.
- **Stand with the saints in Lille for their continuing in one spirit, with one soul, striving together for the faith of the gospel.**
- Consider sending some brothers and sisters, according to the Lord's arrangement, to **join the preparatory meetings on 24 January and the first Lord's Table on 25 January**, for the strengthening and confirmation of this new beginning.

May the Lord continue to move throughout France, raising up many more golden lampstands for His glory, to His praise, and to the shame of His enemy. And may the Lord continue to perfect, establish, strengthen, and ground the saints in all the churches in France.

Practical Information and Registration for the First Lord's Table in Lille, France 24–25 January 2026

To all the churches and to all the saints in the Lord's recovery:

In our previous letter we joyfully announced the first Lord's Table in Lille, France, scheduled for Lord's Day, 25 January 2026, with special preparatory meetings on Saturday, 24 January 2026. We are thankful to the Lord that He has now provided a suitable and pleasant venue for these gatherings and that we can share some practical details and information regarding registration.

1. Venue and surroundings

All the meetings will be held at:

Les espaces Canopy is situated in **Old Town Lille (Vieux-Lille)**, near the **Citadel and surrounding parks**. The area is filled with **many hotels and restaurants**, and there is nearby **parking** as well as **easy access** from both the **Lille Flandres** and **Lille Europe / EuraLille** train stations.

We feel this setting will be very suitable for the saints to gather, to have rich fellowship, and to enjoy the Lord together.

2. Schedule of meetings

Saturday, 24 January 2026 – Preparatory meetings / mini-conference

- **15:00–19:00** – Two sessions, with a short break in between
 - At Les espaces Canopy
 - Simple drinks will be provided

The burden of these meetings is to fellowship concerning God's heart's desire for the church, the Bride of Christ, and the practical expression of the church life in Lille, and to pray and consecrate ourselves to the Lord for His testimony in this city.

 - Following the meeting there will be a **simple lunch together** at the venue until 14:00.

3. Registration and fees

To help us prepare adequately, **registration is requested for all who plan to attend**. We ask that each family or group paying together complete **one registration form**, indicating the number of adults, students/children, and infants.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be no special provisions for children of any age either for meetings or childcare. Parents are expected to closely supervise their own children and not allow them to wander freely in or around the meeting venue.

Registration fees (to help cover the practical costs):

- **30 € per adult**
- **5 € per student / child**
- **Infants: free (0 €)**

Step 2 – Online payment (Stripe)

After (or while) filling out the form, please complete your registration payment via Stripe at the link provided within the registration form.

On the Stripe page you will see two lines:

- **“Inscription adulte (Adult registration)” – 30 €**
- **“Inscription étudiant ou enfant, les bébés : gratuit (Student/child registration, infants free)” – 5 €**

IMPORTANT NOTE: Please adjust the **“Qty”** for each line to match the number of **adults** and **students/children** in your registration. **Infants do not need to be included in Stripe**; they are counted only in the form.

On a phone or narrow screen, you may first need to tap **“View details / Détails”** in the upper right corner of the Stripe page to see and adjust these quantities.

We kindly ask, as far as possible, that you use **the same name and email address** in both the registration form and the Stripe payment so that we can easily match your registration with your payment.

4. Travel and lodging

The saints are responsible for arranging their own **travel and lodging**. Because Les espaces Canopy is in **Vieux-Lille**, near the **Citadel** and within reach of many **restaurants, hotels, and parking options**, we encourage the saints to consider staying either near **Old Town, Place du Général de Gaulle**, or near the **Lille Flandres / Lille Europe (EuraLille)** stations for convenient access to the meetings.

We ask the churches and the saints to continue **praying much** for these days in Lille—for the Lord's rich blessing on the preparatory meetings and upon the first Lord's Table in this city, that Christ may gain in Lille a shining golden lampstand for His testimony.
