The Iberian Peninsula Conference will be held at Torremolinos, Málaga, Spain, on 12-14 December. Please pray for the Lord's speaking and the saints' receiving to advance the Lord's move on the Iberian Peninsula.

4) Gospel trips related to the 2026 Winter Olympics in Italy (4 December 2025—23 February 2026)

The 2026 Winter Olympic Games will be held in Milan and Cortina d'Ampezzo, Italy. Gospel trips during the time of the Torch Relay and the Olympic Games will be conducted from 4 December 2025 through 23 February 2026. Dear saints,

This is our last update in 2025 on our progress with the translation of the New Testament Recovery Version into the Slovak and Czech languages.

It was a year ago when, after thorough fellowship and many prayers, we started our preparations for the translation. After all the months of study, followed by a final review of the entire Greek course and a successful closing test for all three Greek-to-Slovak and Greek-to-Czech translators at the end of October, we held an intense few days of training on the practical side of the translation itself in mid-November.

Today, December 1, we finally began the translation of the Gospel of Matthew. The translation of this first book is expected to take us until June 2026, at which time we hope and expect to put this first Gospel of the New Testament Recovery Version, complete with footnotes, into the hands of the Czech and Slovak saints as a foretaste.

These first weeks and months are very crucial for the whole team of six translators, as we will all still be learning ways of working individually and corporately as a team. It is also a new experience of applying everything previously learned into practice, learning to work with new translation tools, and establishing working procedures.

Please pray with us:

- For the Lord to be our wisdom in setting the best principles for our work from the very beginning.
- That the whole team will be kept from all unnecessary distractions to remain focused on the translation and keep the schedule as much as possible.
- That the Lord may more and more become and remain the sole goal and real focus of all saints in the team and in their daily work.
